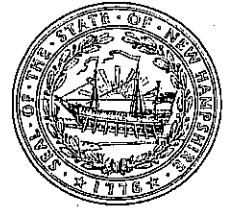

On behalf of the NH Wetlands Council, I am in receipt of your petition for appeal in the above-captioned matter. Please be advised that your petition is insufficient for the Council to accept it as an appeal at this time.

NH CODE ADMIN. RULES Env-WtC 100-200 specifies the proper procedure for filing an appeal with the NH Wetlands Council. A copy of this rule is enclosed for your benefit, and also is available on-line at <http://www.gencourt.state.nh.us/rules/env-wtc100-200.html>. In particular, please note the requirements of Env-WtC 203.02 relative to what the petition for appeal must include, as well as the requirements of Env-WtC 202.07 relative to the required number of copies.

If you wish to pursue your appeal, you must file a notice of appeal that meets the requirements of Env-WtC 100-200. If you file the notice of appeal within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, it will be treated as being filed within the time period for filing an appeal, and I will forward your submittal to the Wetlands Council as soon as I receive it. If you do not file a notice of appeal that meets the requirements of Env-WtC 100-200 within 30 days, the Wetlands Council may vote to not accept your petition.
