Please accept this letter as my Appearance on behalf of The Landing Boat Club "LBC") in this matter.

On behalf of my client we must state that we contest this Appeal vigorously, as the LBC has been assured by The Dock Doctors, the agents who filed the application for the Permit, that they properly followed the notification requirements. The fact that the Town of Newbury's records, as supplied by the Town to the Doc Doctors, were not effectively changed by the so-called Porter Trust, a Trust allegedly created by a clause in a Will that neither the Dock Doctors or The Landing Boat Club were provided, does not make the Dock Doctor's notifications defective. The Dock Doctors also assure the LBC that the docks were built to the same specifications as those earlier approved by the Wetlands Council pursuant to a Permit that was not contested by The Porter Trust or its predecessor in title.
