The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services hereby issues the enclosed Title V Operating Permit in accordance with the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules *Env-A 100 et seq., New Hampshire Rules Governing the Control of Air Pollution*. The Region I office of the United States Environmental Protection Agency has completed its final review of the proposed Title V Operating Permit and does not object to its issuance. Please note that Sections X and XI of the final Title V Permit were amended to clarify that the Title V permit renewal application must be **received by the Department** at least 6 months before the expiration date. This letter has no effect on the time frame for citizen petitions. The period for a citizen's petition shall expire on December 22, 2009.

In addition, enclosed please find a questionnaire distributed by the Department of Environmental Services, Public Information and Permitting Unit. We are constantly trying to improve our permit processing and your feedback is greatly appreciated.
